Many of the noise and alcohol related complaints related to the Dronfield Beer Festival, the nuisance youths related to a rave at Shillito Woods, the nuisance motorcycle complaints resulted in Section 59 warning being given to the driver

The newly appointed Inspector Glenn Hoggard attended the meeting. Now that the Community Partnership meetings have been dissolved, he asked if the Town Council would be willing to have an agenda item to discuss future targets within the Town Council meetings. He has been working on statistical data and has found that crime is 30% down this year; violence is 46% down and stealing offences 38% down; in summary Dronfield is a safe place to live. The monthly surgeries are still being held on market day in Dronfield and at Unstone Post Office, giving the public opportunity to bring their problems to the Police in person.

The Town Mayor thanked the police for their attendance and they left at this point.

10 Outside Services Report

<u>Litter Bins</u> – The Dog and Litter bins continue to be emptied on a weekly basis.

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Grass cutting continues, for four weeks Lightwood Landscapes is undertaking the cutting of all areas.

<u>Footpaths</u> – The footpaths that will be maintained under the Minor Maintenance Agreement with Derbyshire County Council has been assessed in line with the grant receivable. The ones that Dronfield Town Council are to maintain have been strimmed and any shrub/bushes cut back, this will continue on a monthly basis.

<u>Cliffe Park</u> – Outside Service staff have been working within the park, cutting back bushes around the entrance to the park; the hedge row around the bowling green has started to be cut back and reduced in height. The park will be ready for the forthcoming events.

<u>Culverts</u> – The culverts along the Leabrook valley area have all been cleaned out and are being inspected on a daily/weekly basis dependent upon weather.

<u>Flower Beds</u> – All the Towns flower beds have been emptied and rotovated over. The summer bedding plants have been planted around the Town; there is a mixture of Begonias, Geraniums, Marigolds, Petunias and Lobelia edging.

<u>Hanging Baskets</u> -There are 39 lighting columns that have hanging baskets fitted to them and will be watered on a weekly basis or if weather hot twice weekly.

<u>Muga Pitch</u> – The MUGA pitch is being well used and is inspected on a daily basis the majority of the maintenance is now being undertaken in house.

<u>Play areas</u> – The annual play inspections have been received and implementation of the recommendations is underway. Soft surface at Stonelow has been repaired, bushes changed on swings at Sindlefingen, new swing seats installed at Hilltop. There is still some maintenance to be done within some play areas but will be rectified according to priority.

Other Tasks -

Some plumbing issues have been rectified at Stonelow cricket, Coal Aston Football and Stonelow bottom cricket pavilions.

Gala preparations are on going.

Party in the Park preparations are ongoing.

The Ashgate Midnight Walk was held on Sat 22 June, the start was from Cliffe Park, and the event was set up and went of without any problems.

Various report forms have been actioned and points rectified.

<u>Hilltop</u> – It was reported that a bench had gone missing from Hilltop Recreation Ground; the public thought that DTC staff had removed for maintenance, the bench had not been removed by DTC staff but has in fact been stolen, the security bolts had been cut and bench removed. 3 Phase for Stonelow

The project for a refurbished / replacement pavilion at the bottom of Stonelow Recreation Ground has been discussed for a period of time. The project was put on hold as there were

problems with getting sufficient power to the building in order to run showers. The cost of installation of 3 Phase from the top of the site appeared to cost prohibitive.

During a meeting with Dronfield Town Football Club the supply of 3 phase to Stonelow Recreation Ground was discussed. The Football Club have funds of £22,000 to put in 70KVA of power for their floodlights and they require 50 KVA to run the lights.

Two electricians have been contacted and they consider that 30 KVA would be sufficient to run the required number of showers following refurbishment of the bottom pavilion.

The Football Club needed to place the order for the 3 phase by 14 June 2013 for the work to take place in accordance with the grant funders' conditions.

In order to save monies in the future and to kick start the project on the bottom Pavilion the Football Club have been asked to order 80 KVA and that the Town Council will fund the cost of the additional 10 KVA.
