8. Outside Services Report

The following tasks have been carried out during the month of November.

Poppies - The 138 Poppies have been removed from all the lighting columns.

Litter/Dog Bins - The litter and dog bins continue to be emptied on a weekly basis, this is carried out every Thursday and consists of 2 men doing the whole route, and they carry out a visual inspection of the play areas/equipment at the same time. We are still waiting a delivery of some new dog bins – large/small to replace bins around the Town.

Anything that is picked up on the Visual inspection is entered on to the forms when they return to workshop and rectified as soon as possible.

Hedgerows - Lightwood Landscapes have cut all the hedgerows around the parks; the areas that have been cut back are,

- Dronfield Woodhouse - hedge between bowling green and football pitch.
- Jubilee – hedge along front of park/Green lane.
- Coal Aston – Birches fold, hedge at back of houses next to play area, and hedge on lane next to football pavilion.
- Hilltop – hedge to side of play area.

Cemetery - The baskets are emptied around the Cemetery on a Monday and Friday.

Grass Cutting – The grass was cut in the first week of November; this was the last cut this year. We have been blowing the footpaths and roadways of leafs around the cemetery on a Monday and depending on how much has fallen on a Thursday as well.

Cemetery Grass Cutting – The Cemetery had the grass cut for the last time this year at the beginning of November.

Weed Spraying – We have weed sprayed all the flower beds and they have been rotovated, the aim is to try and kill back most of the chickweed and weeds that keep growing in the beds, the tennis courts at Coal Aston along with the area around Cemetery road play area below fencing have been sprayed.

Muga Pitch – The MUGA pitch has again been closed due to the lockdown restrictions.

Tennis Courts – The tennis courts at Cliffe Park, Dronfield Woodhouse and Coal Aston have all been locked due to lockdown restrictions.

Shrubbery/Hedges – The area around Dronfield Woodhouse Sports and Social club has had the shrubbery and overgrown bushes cut back. Jubilee has had the hedges within the park cut back where Lightwood landscapes could not get access with their tractor.

Hep A & B – O/S Staff have had the third course of Hep A & B inoculations done, all that's required now is to have a blood test taken in 2 months' time to see if the vaccinations have worked.

Hilltop Play Area – The play area has had new bow top fencing and gate installed around the play area.

Remembrance Sunday – The Outside Services staff were on duty, helping to set up the area around the Library gardens by cordoning off the area to prevent the public from accessing the War Memorial as per guidelines issued. They also set up and operated the P.A system.

Christmas Trees/decoration – The Christmas lights have all been inspected and tested ready for installation around the Town.

On Monday 23rd December we collected the 26ft tree for Library gardens, Dave Bolsover picked the tree up using his trailer, and Gary Fletcher supplied the JCB which helped us to install the tree by lifting it into the tube installed at library gardens. Icicle lights have been put up along with some tree wrap around the tree next to the High Street junction.

It was the same scenario for installing the 22ft tree at Sindlefingen Park; Gary Fletcher had installed a new manhole which was the perfect diameter for installing the tree into.

We hired a cherry picker to help with the decoration of the lights on both trees.

There were an additional 6 trees which were picked up on Wednesday, that have been installed around the town this year – Hilltop, Carr lane, Lucas Gardens, Train station, Snape Hill and the Pond - Coal Aston. They have been decorated with 600 white LED battery lights and fenced off for safety.

16 Christmas trees have been installed around the Civic Hall and High Street along with an additional 5 trees that have been installed on the shops at Dronfield Bottom/Chesterfield Road.

Play Areas – Maintenance has been carried out on the play areas;

Birches Fold - None

Cliffe Park – The roundabout has been reported to Creative Play as this is has been fixed but is now faulty and not running freely. The Zip wire has been mended with new threaded bar installed.

Hilltop – New Bowtop fencing and gate has been installed in front of the old fencing which will be removed.

Moonpenny Way - None

Stonelow - None

Dronfield Woodhouse – Quotes received for the new piece of equipment. Removed toddler swing due to damage.

Cemetery Rd – New play equipment has been installed.

Tennis courts – Quotes received for the refurbishment of the courts at Dronfield Woodhouse and Coal Aston.

Tennis Court – Dronfield Woodhouse has one tennis court and one basketball court. We have cut back the brambles from the edging along the back of the court adjacent to the hedgerow.

Tennis Court – Coal Aston has one tennis court and one basketball court. We have sprayed the weeds within the court and around the perimeter.

Tennis Courts – Cliffe Park

No 1 court, no maintenance required on all 3 courts, weed spray around perimeter.

I have asked that all weeds are removed from the ditches around the bowling greens.

Other Tasks - Agendas and other DTC material placed on notice boards and are removed when meetings/events have taken place. Banners removed/replaced on from the front of the Civic Hall when required. Various reports have been actioned around the Town.
