Council notes:

- The national Labour Party Leader's deeply concerning recent statements in relation to housebuilding. In particular, in an interview with Times Radio reported on the 17<sup>th</sup> May, he outlined his pledge 'to make Labour the party of housebuilding by relaxing planning restrictions and allowing more housebuilding on our Green Belt.'
- The Labour Leader has also committed to reintroducing mandatory, top-down and nationally set housebuilding targets for local authorities, which were previously scrapped by the Coalition Government, flying in the face of localism.
- The news reports of the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023 that new local Labour council leaders would be meeting with the Party Leader and were being tasked with *'reviewing local housing and development plans*', with a view to providing even more housing.

Council strongly condemns Labour's recent policy developments and the damage they would do to green belt communities, like Dronfield and Coal Aston.

Council will write to urge the new Labour leadership of North East Derbyshire District Council to clarify to the public about how they intend to review development plans to provide even more housing and what risks this may pose to the green belt.

Council believes that local residents should be able to play an active part in our local planning system and that it should work to preserve the beautiful rural character of our District, especially the green belt. Where new homes are needed for local people, these should be provided in the right places and not on the green belt, which serves the vital purposes of restricting urban sprawl, preserving the character of historic towns, preventing the coalescence of communities, and assisting in urban regeneration.
