

9. **Barn to rear of 195 and 197 Carr Lane**
Built in the C18. Two storey building of five bays. Built of coursed random coal measure sandstone,
10. **Dronfield Woodhouse Hall, Carr Lane**
Built in the C16, with C18, C19 and C20 alterations. Built of coursed squared coal measure sandstone rising from a shallow plinth, with stone slate roof with coped gables with moulded kneeler stones with ashlar gable and ridge chimneys. The building has a central two storey range with a gabled range to each end, that at the south west end projecting forward and being of two stories with attics. (Listed Building)
11. **The barn, Dronfield Woodhouse Hall, Carr Lane**
Built in the mid C17 with later C18 and C20 alterations. Now converted to residential accommodation. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with ashlar window and door stone dressings, quoins, coped gables with kneeler stones and welsh slate roof. U shaped form with a central range of six bays, the outer bays projecting northwards towards the old hall.
12. **No 4 Barley mews**
Built in the C20. Two storey, three bay building. Built of coursed coal measure sandstone with slate roof, coped gables with stone kneelers and gable chimney. Stacked sliding sash windows with ashlar stone cills and heads. Central projecting porch with coped gable roof incorporating kneeler stones.
13. **No 194 Carr Lane**
Probably of C18 date. Two storey three bay farmhouse. Constructed in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with stone slate roof and east gable chimney. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills in the outer bays and central doorway with stone surround
14. **No 192 Carr Lane**
Built in the C18. Two storey three bay house. Built of coursed squared coal measure sandstone with stone slate roof and gable chimneys. Stacked windows UPVc with mock Georgian glazing bars, stone heads and cills in the outer bays and central doorway with projecting stone and UPVc porch.
15. **'Parsons Croft' No 190 Carr Lane**
Late C17 or C18 date. Two storey, three bay house. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with mock stone slate roof with coped gable to the western end and off centre ridge chimney.
16. **Barn beside No 190 Carr Lane**
Late C17 or C18 date. Two storey barn. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with corrugated tin sheet roof. External steps to the first floor at the eastern end.
17. **No 176 Carr Lane.**
Built late C18 early C19 with later alterations. Single storey with attics. Three bays. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with welsh slate roofs and brick gable chimneys, stone lintols and stone cills windows in outer bays and stone surround to door with projecting front proch to central bay.
18. **No's 174 Carr Lane**
Built late C18 early C19 with later alterations. Two storey three bay house. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with welsh slate roofs and gable chimneys, stacked windows with stone lintols and stone cills, ground floor windows now projecting bay windows, in outer bays and door with stone lintol to central bay.
19. **No's 158 to 168 Carr Lane**
Built in the mid C19. Terrace of six workers cottages in three handed pairs within the terrace. Individual cottages have two bays, one containing stacked windows with stone heads and cills, the other the door with stone surround. Built of coursed squared coal measure sandstone with some stone slate roofs and ridge chimneys central to each pairing of cottages.
20. **No 154/156 Carr Lane**
Built in the mid C19 with C20 alterations. Two storey, three bay house. Built of coursed squared coal measure sandstone building with welsh slate roof with coped gables and ridge chimney. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills with front projecting porch.

21. No 152 Carr Lane

Built in the mid C19 with C20 additions. Two storey five bay house. constructed of coursed squared coal measure sandstone with welsh slate roof with coped gables and gable chimney. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills, with large ground floor bow window. Front projecting porch.

22. Park Farm House, No 144 Carr Lane.

Late C18 or early C19 date with C20 alterations. Two storey, three bay house at angle to road. Built of coursed squared coal measure sandstone with gabled welsh slate roof and gable chimneys. Single storey narrow projecting glass and timber extension to front façade. Modern UPVc conservatory to gable end.

23. No 138 Carr Lane

Built in the C18. Two Storey, four bay house. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with gabled welsh slate roof with ridge and gable chimneys. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills.

24. Middle Farm, No 145 Carr Lane

Possibly C18 in date with C19 and C20 alterations. Two storey house.

Originally a barn prior to becoming a farmhouse, probably in the early C19. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with modern composite roof slates.

25. No 153 Carr Lane

Built in the mid C18. Two storey, three bay house. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with welsh slate roof with timber gutters and gable chimneys. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills containing modern UPVc windows with central door with stone surround

26. No 155 Carr Lane.

Built 1856. Two storey, three bay house. Built in coursed squared coal measure sandstone with coped gabled welsh slate roof with timber gutters and gable chimneys. Stacked windows with stone heads and cills containing modern stained timber sliding sash windows with central projecting porch.
