The following tasks have been carried out during the month of November

Litter Bins - The Dog and Litter bins continue to be emptied on a weekly basis.

<u>Play Areas</u> - Maintenance continues on the play areas. We are awaiting spares to repair the swing at Sindelfingen Park. The area has been cordoned off to stop public from using this piece of equipment.

<u>Cemetery</u> -The team have been in the cemetery maintaining all areas, all the grass areas were cut and strimmed at the beginning of November and that was the last cut for this year. The baskets are emptied on a Monday and Friday, and the toilets cleaned twice a week.

Hilltop – British coal have been back to the area at Hilltop W/C 27/10/14 to cap the hole and make good the area around where they had to dig up. This has now been completed.

<u>Xmas Lights</u> – The Christmas lights have been installed around the Library Gardens and the tree has been installed and decorated ready for the light switch on.

<u>Shrubbery and Hedgerow</u> – The entrance into Dronfield Sports and Social Club has all been cut back, the shrubbery around 122 Carr Lane has been reduced so we can assess the state of the wall that is in need of repair.

Lightwood Landscape's has been around all areas cutting back/down the hedgerows that are on DTC owned land.

<u>Coal Aston</u> – Repairs to the fence on the car park, a vehicle went through between the main posts and ended up in the ditch at the far side of the football pitches. No one was in the vehicle at the time.

<u>Grit Bins</u> – The grit bins have all been checked and loosened up ready for the winter period, we have a skip with 8 tons in the yard ready for when we need to fill up the grit bins.

The Builder's Solicitor has written to Bell & Buxton confirming that the car park will be cleared of building materials and cleaned down by the end of the week commencing 21<sup>st</sup> November. Also his client is embarrassed about the completion of the easement and the funds he is expecting are taking longer to come through than anticipated. He has advised his client that the consequences of not completing the easement are that the Council could withdraw its support at any time.
