1 Apologies

3 Public Speaking

3a Planning matters

15/00965/FL Dronfield Town Football Club - Football Ground – Frithwood Drive Application to vary Conditions 2 3 and 5 of planning approval 10/00948/FL to allow use of the floodlights until 10.30pm for cup matches and to increase No of games to 40 per season.

Darren Bradwell of Dronfield Town Football Club stated that the current lighting of switching off at 9.45pm is not suitable for a 7.45pm kick off for a cup game that may go to penalties. They cannot enter the cup games if the lights will be switched off at 9.45pm although this will only happen on minimum occasions.

The reason for the increase in games from 30 to 40 is that the reserve team now play in the division below the 1st team and at present play at Gosforth Fields but this will not be possible next season due to the meshing surrounding the ground making it not a spectator friendly ground. If they do not get permission for the 40 games the reserve team will have to be relegated. The cup games could be one and half hours extra only in one season.

3b General Matters

There were no comments on general matters

3c Police Matters

The police sent apologies for nonattendance.

Anti-Social Behaviour - 22 Incidents reported this month.

The bulk of the ASB incidents are groups of youths gathering on the streets of Pentland Rd, Civic Centre, Greendale Shops, Sainsbury's Car park and Coniston Road. Quite a few of these incidents have been on the nights that the youth club is being run (Fridays). From speaking to the groups we have identified that there is ultimately nowhere for them to go; where there are places, they are unlit and or muddy. Generally the reason for the groups congregating and causing issues is boredom.

Crime – Overall the crime figures are reduced by a third from December 2014 to December 2015.

The figures identify an issue with business premises being targeted this month. To combat this, patrols have been increased and crime prevention officers have visited the individual premises to provide advice and reassurance.

The Co-op at Greendale has also been a target this month. Enquiries are on-going and we believe they are being targeted by a team.

Overall it has been a fairly peaceful Christmas and New Year.

5 Derbyshire & Derby Mineral Local Plan

Mr Rob Murfin – Head of Planning Services Derbyshire County Council addressed the Council on the subject of the Derbyshire & Derby Mineral Local Plan. The Government requires plans to set out a positive approach to planning policy guidance for mineral extraction in the area. The Plan will set local criteria and policies to help determining any applications for minerals developments, for example limestone, sand & gravel or fracking. There is a wealth of information on the DCC website on the consultation on the plan with details at www.tiny.cc/MinsPlan.

Mr Murfin explained the position in relation to fracking applications underneath land in private ownership and the rights of individuals. He clarified that while licences had indeed been issued by government over large areas of the country (including parts of Derbyshire) formal planning permission was still required to carry out fracking schemes. He confirmed that to date there had been no interest in submitting applications for fracking in Derbyshire, but this didn't rule out such in the future. He added that because of geological conditions, Derbyshire may not be in the first round of applications for actual fracking schemes."

Footpaths - The footpaths that are looked after DTC all been litter picked and any debris removed.

Hedgerows and shrubbery – We have continued to cut back certain areas around the Town as the weather has been good and we have been able to carry out a lot of maintenance.

Christmas Lights – The Christmas light switch on went ahead without any hitches, and was enjoyed by the many children and parents that turned up to see the Mayor switch the lights on.

Christmas Fest – The Christmas fest which was held in the Civic Hall with community stalls and Santa's Grotto which were all well attended, there was a steady flow of children and parents having a go on the children's rides which was held in the car park behind the Library.

Tree works – An order has been placed with Underwoods Tree Surgeons to carry out the works required around the Town.

Electrical - Electrical testing of all fuse boards, lighting circuit's and power sockets has now been completed.

Cliffe Park – A new hand rail has been installed on both sides of the steps outside the kiosk.

Grass Cutting – We have been out cutting all the small areas DTC own, as the grass has not stopped growing at the present time.

Allotments – All water has been turned off and all taps left open.
