#### 7 Outside Services Report

The following tasks have been carried out during the month of March.

Litter Bins - The Dog and Litter bins continue to be emptied on a weekly basis.

Play Areas - Maintenance continues on the play areas.

Cemetery - The baskets are emptied around the Cemetery and toilets cleaned on a Monday and Friday.

Notice Boards - The notice boards have all been cleaned up with the removal of any old and non-charity posters being removed.

<u>Benches</u> – The maintenance on the benches for Sindlefingen Park has been completed and 8 new benches have been installed around the Play area.

<u>Football</u> – We still currently open up and lock up for the football at Coal Aston and clean out the changing on a Monday/Tuesday.

Muga Pitch – We have purchased 2 new LED lights and these have now been installed, if these are suitable then we will look at replacing all the lights around the Muga pitch.

Workshop — I am looking at getting some quotes for refurbishing the office and canteen/changing area, the office I have is not adequate to work in when the weather is cold/freezing outside, this area and canteen requires to be made bigger by extending the inside area and new brick or wood portions being built with new doorways, ceiling and flooring to be done, this could be built on the mezzanine floor above the existing office. Also the lack of heating requires looking at. Over the last few weeks the temp in the office/canteen has been 8 – 13 degrees. I have a drawing of what the office/canteen would look like. I have had two quotes for the works and waiting a further one quote.

<u>Cliffe Park/Civic Hall</u> – The Outside Services staff have been required to do some extra duties in the park, opening up, cleaning and setting up the lodge and also helping out at the Civic Hall.

<u>Church Clock</u> – The Outside Services wind up the Church Clock, this is being done on a Monday and Friday morning, and this requires 2 men to do the task safely.

<u>Grounds Maintenance machinery</u> – The lawn mowers from the cemetery have been returned after servicing, one mower is beyond repair so will require a new purchase, this will be up to the Burial Committee to decide if we purchase a new one, this leaves 3 working mowers in the cemetery.

Cemetery – It has been another busy month in the cemetery with burials and the garden of rest.

<u>Grass Cutting</u> – We have started cutting grass around the Town with all play areas and small open spaces being cut, we will start the large open spaces next week - 27<sup>th</sup> March.

Workshop Fencing – We are still waiting on the fencing that was removed when the trailer was stolen in July 16 to be replaced with new palisade fencing.

Other Various reports have been actioned around the Town. Maintenance has been carried out on various Council Buildings. The staff have been quite busy covering for holidays.

It is only available on-line with few hard copies available. The only public consultation held in Dronfield was very busy and could not accommodate with the many residents who attended. Many were not able to speak to planners. The Council ask that the consultation is extended and further drop in session organised.

#### 259/16-17 RESOLVED

That the Council write to North East Derbyshire District Council to object to the Draft Local plan proposed on the following grounds:

- a) the Council oppose the NEDDC draft local plan to remove green belt from Dronfield to build new housing which will reduce the green spaces separating our town from its neighbouring settlements and so threaten the future distinct identity of Dronfield.
- b) The new housing targets set by NEDDC are too high and based on unrealistic assumptions on growth and jobs
- c) All suitable brownfield sites in Dronfield have not been exhaustively researched but considered together with windfall housing sites, offer realistic housing targets based on historic data and a natural sustainable rate of growth
- d) The infrastructure in Dronfield is already under stress and could not accommodate the level of housing proposed.
- e) The increase in road traffic, including an increase in heavy goods vehicles, pollution and the loss of greenfield and recreation sites will threaten the quality of life of existing and future residents.

Members discussed the following motion:

That Dronfield Town Council reopens negotiations with Rykneld Homes regarding the scheme agreed in principle during the previous administration (Dronfield Town Council 2011-2015) to utilise the 'Alma site' for Housing including the provision of up to forty units for rent guaranteed for people with Dronfield Connections and that this plot of land is submitted to North East Derbyshire District Council to be designated as Housing land as part of the consultations on their Local Plan Review.
