1. Apologies

2. Declaration of Interests

There were no declarations of interest.

3. Approval of Minutes

It was RESOLVED to approve the minutes of the Events Advisory Committee Meeting held on 15th February 2023 as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

4. Any items for exclusion of the public

There were no items for discussion which required the public to be excluded.

5. HM King Charles III Coronation

Members discussed plans for the Coronation.

Members were updated on the Extreme Wheels booking for 2023. The Assistant Town Clerk informed members that booking is going ahead as planned and Dronfield Police have informed the Council that they have booked them to come to Coal Aston.

It was RESOLVED to note this update.

7. Dronfield Gala 2023

The Projects and Communications Officer gave the following update on the 2023 Dronfield Gala:

Members were updated that at that point there were 4 community stalls confirmed 3 commercial and 5 food & drink stalls, giving a total of 11.
