This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of the Parish of Dronfield require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 16 August 2023.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Derbyshire for the Parish of Dronfield shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date when it is confirmed and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Restricted Byway and Footpath from Scarsdale Road to Hallows Lane – Parish of Dronfield) Modification Order 2023.

C-D	Restricted Byway in the Parish of Dronfield from Point C (GR SK 3555 7792) proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction to Hallowes Lane at Point D (GR SK 3564 7780), a distance of 154 metres or thereabouts with a width varying between 3.5 metres and 19 metres as shown shaded grey on the Order plan.

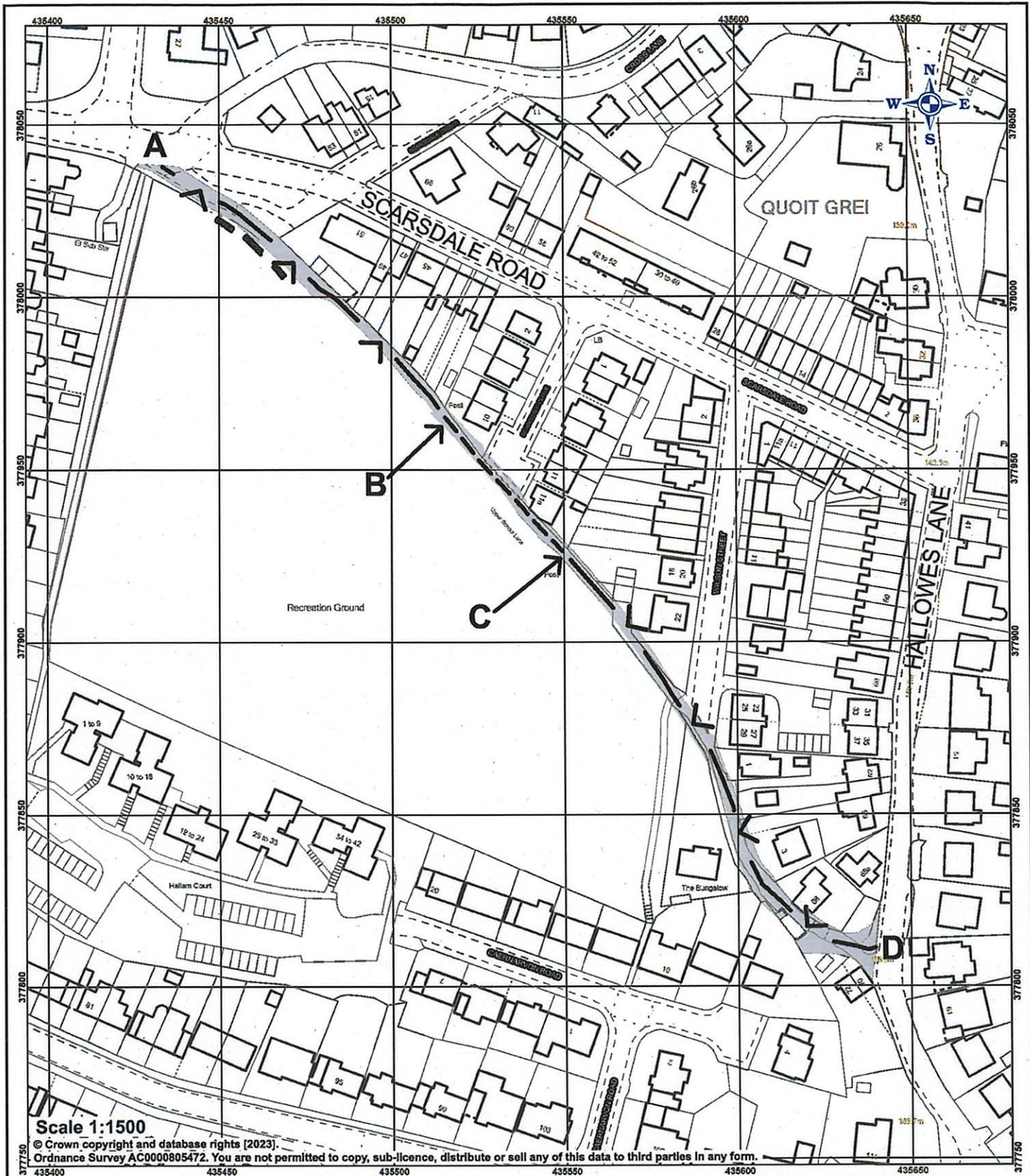
