Dear Neighbour,

Vegetation Management Work: Dronfield, S18

I am writing to tell you that we need to remove vegetation and undertake essential maintenance on the railway near to your property (see site map below).



Vegetation and loose rock will be removed from the limestone rock faces within the rail corridor. This essential work is required to reduce the risk of falling rock disrupting the operational railway.

We'll be working overnight during the following dates/times.

- 22:00 Monday 13 November 2023 to Tuesday 14 November 08:00hrs
- 22:00 Tuesday 14 November 2023 to Wednesday 15 November 08:00hrs
- 22:00 Wednesday 15 November 2023 to Thursday 16 November 08:00hrs
- 22:00 Thursday 16 November 2023 to Friday 17 November 08:00hrs

We take our responsibility to manage the railway safely and look after the habitats on our land very seriously. Work will be carried out considering the safety risks to passenger trains and our staff, the natural environment, and the local community.

I understand that working near your property overnight is far from ideal and I am sorry in advance for any disruption this may cause. However, the work is essential, and the team need to undertake the work at night as it is the safest time for the team to access the railway, due to the low numbers of trains that run at this time.

The nature of our work often means some disturbance is unavoidable, with the teams using vehicles, machinery & lighting. The team are aware that they are working close to your home and will try to minimise unnecessary disruption as much as possible.

I hope this information is helpful and again I am sorry for any disturbance this essential vegetation management may cause.
