(Dronfield, Dronfield Woodhouse, Unstone & Holmesfield, North East Derbyshire)

(Various Waiting Restrictions Order 2024)

Derbyshire County Council proposes making an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to restrict waiting by vehicles (except those delivering or collecting goods or loading and unloading) on the following lengths of road:No Waiting at Any Time

B6054 Main Road, Holmesfield

South-east side

From a point 6 metres south-west of its junction with Cowley Lane to a point 24 metres north-east of that junction.

Cowley Lane, Holmesfield

North side

From its junction with the B6054 Main Road for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction.

South side

From its junction with the B6054 Main Road for a distance of 13 metres in an easterly direction.

B6057 Sheffield Road, Dronfield

North-east side

From a point 27 metres south-east of its junction with Snape Hill Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

B6057 Unstone Hill, Unstone (Lay-by adjacent to former Filling Station)

North side

From its junction with the B6057 Unstone Hill for a distance of 53 metres in an easterly direction.

South-west side

From its junction with the B6057 Unstone Hill for a distance of 14 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Burns Drive, Dronfield

North-west side

From its junction with Shakespeare Crescent for a distance of 13 metres in a north-easterly direction.

South-east side

From its junction with Shakespeare Crescent for a distance of 67 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Shakespeare Crescent

North-east side

From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Burns Drive to a point 15 metres south-east of that junction Callywhite Lane, Dronfield

South side

From a point 33 metres west of Birch House Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

From a point 175 metres west of Birch House Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.

North side

From its junction with Birch House Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.

From a point 33 metres west of its junction with Birch House Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 64 metres.

From a point 175 metres west of Birch House Way in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.

Both sides

From its junction with Navigation Way in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 60 metres including around the centre of the mini-roundabout and the outside of the mini-roundabout.

West side

From a point 78 metres north-west of its junction with Navigation Way in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.

East side

From a point 90 metres north-west of its junction with Navigation Way in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

Hallowes Drive, Dronfield

South-east side

From its junction with Hallowes Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a north-easterly direction.

North-west side

From its junction with Hallowes Lane for a distance of 18 metres in a north-easterly direction.

North side

From its junction with Hallowes Rise for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

Highgate Drive, Dronfield

North-east side

From its junction with Hallowes Rise for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Hallowes Rise, Dronfield

East side

From its junction with Highgate Drive for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

West side

From its junction with Hallowes Drive for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction.

Longcroft Road, Dronfield Woodhouse

South side

From a point 12 metres west of its junction with Smithy Croft to a point 17 metres east of that junction.

Smithy Croft, Dronfield Woodhouse

East side

From its junction with Longcroft Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

West side

From its junction with Longcroft Road for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.

Limited Waiting, Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6pm, Waiting Limited to 2 Hours, No Return Within 1 Hour

B6057 Sheffield Road, Dronfield

North-east side

From a point 37 metres south-east of its junction with Snape Hill Lane for a distance of 71 metres in a south-easterly direction.

No Stopping on School Entrance Clearway Markings, Monday to Friday, 8am to 4pm

Smithy Croft, Dronfield

West side

From a point 20 metres south of its junction with Longcroft Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.

Any permanent Traffic Regulation Orders made prior to this Order, insofar as they relate to the lengths of road listed above, will be revoked.

Exemptions will be made for vehicles used in connection with any building operation or demolition; removal of any obstruction to traffic; carrying out of statutory powers or duties taking in petrol etc, from any garage situated within the lengths of road; or as part of a funeral or wedding cortege. The usual exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles will also apply.
