The following tasks have been carried out during the first 3 weeks of June 2023

<u>Litter/Dog Bins</u> - The litter and dog bins continue to be emptied on a weekly basis, this is carried out every Thursday and consists of two men doing the whole route and several are also emptied on a Monday.

<u>Cemetery</u> - The baskets are emptied around the Cemetery on a Monday and Friday.

Tasks around Dronfield

- 3. Sindelfingen Park tree branches removed from lower parts of trees to allow for grass cutting.
- 4. Wall been repaired on Sheffield Road
- 5. Various quotes for work have been sought
- 6. Actions from Fire Risk Assessments have been undertaken

Cemetery – Outside Services staff have been topping up some of the graves.

All areas around the cemetery have had the grass cut and strimmed and weed sprayed where required.

Play Area
